Construction of Dawson Co. motorsports park adds jobs

DAWSONVILLE - Twenty-seven people have new-found employment thanks to the construction of a motorsports park in Dawsonville.

Jeremy Porter, CEO of Atlanta Motorsports Park, said Wednesday that 25 people have been rehired by TW Phillips, a Dawsonville grading company, and two contractors have been hired by logging company Martin Timber.

Porter said the recent job creation will only stand to have a ripple effect.

"The ripple effect in business for a motorsports country club is \$30 million to \$60 million a year," he said.

In addition to its motorsports events, Porter said the facility will also offer a venue for teen driving programs and for law enforcement training.

He said weather permitting, the entire project should be completed in eight to 10 months.
